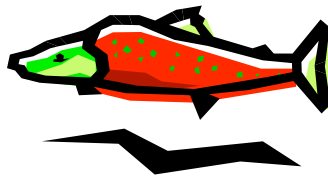
Population of this state

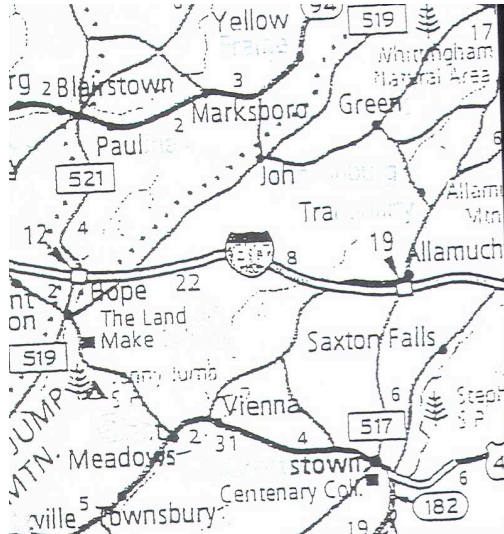
